Empowering Nurses and Advancing the Nursing Profession

Nurses are the backbone of America's health system – delivering exceptional care, driving healthcare innovation, and advocating for patients across every setting. As demand for healthcare grows and workforce shortages persist, nurses play a vital role in closing gaps and improving health outcomes nationwide.

Since 1956, the American Nurses Foundation (ANF) – the charitable arm of the American Nurses Association – has supported the nation's nurses in partnership with those who believe in their transformative power. It is our belief in The Power of Nurses™ that fuels ANF's Reimagining Nursing Initiative, through which we empower nurses to design and scale nurse-led solutions at the intersection of education, reimbursement, technology and well-being across the profession. Over the last five years, ANF has invested \$52.6 million across 136 grants, directly impacting the lives of 3 million nurses.

IN 2024, WE...

Invested in Nurse-led Research and Innovation ANF funds nurse-driven research and innovation that improves care, access, and outcomes for all. Grantees across 41 states are scaling their programs, surpassing their goals, and delivering concrete advances to their communities. Since 1956, ANF has supported over 1,100 nurse researchers, with recent projects exploring nurse compensation and meaningful recognition, nurse observations and electronic health records, and new approaches in education and certification.

Established New Approaches to Nurse Well-Being | ANF's *Nurse Well-Being: Building Peer and Leadership Support* helps nurses effectively manage sustained workplace stress by adapting the Stress First Aid model – originally developed for the military – for nurses. Based on the successful outcomes of the three-year pilot project, we are now expanding the program into rural and long-term care settings.

Expanded the Pipeline of Scholars and Fellows Who Represent their Communities | To ensure a thriving nursing workforce, ANF – in partnership with the American Nurses Association (ANA) – invests in the next generation of nurses through scholarships and fellowships that create pathways for aspiring and current nurses to advance their careers. This includes the Jeannine Rivet National Leadership Award, scholarships for nursing students, as well as ANA's Minority Fellowship Program, which has prepared advanced practice nurses from all backgrounds to lead in behavioral healthcare, research, education, and policy for over 50 years.
